TRADEMARK

REGISTRATION

Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate;
2. An Extract from the Commercial Register or a Certificate of Incorporation, duly legalized by Apostille or up to Bahrain Consulate (reflecting company activity);
3. A certified copy of the priority document, if priority is claimed; and
4. Five prints of the mark.

- The POA in the name of same applicant may be used for subsequent filings.
- All the documents must be submitted at the time of filing. However, a faxed copy can be submitted together with the application form in order to secure filing number and date. The original legalized document can be filed within 90 days from the date of filing the application.

Time frame:

- 1) Filing up to Examination: 12-14 months
- 2) Examination up to Publication: 3-5 months
- 3) Opposition Period: 60 days from the publication date
- 4) End of opposition period up to issuance of registration certificate: 2-4 weeks
- 5) Total estimated time frame: 18-22 months

The above time frame is for a normal/smooth processing of a trademark application, in case of no objections by the trademark examiner or no oppositions from a third party.

RENEWAL

Filing Requirement:

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate.

CHANGE OF NAME OR ADDRESS

Filing Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate; and
2. A Certificate of change of name/address, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate.

ASSIGNMENT

Filing Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney from the Assignee, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate;
2. A Deed of Assignment, signed by both parties, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate; and
3. An Extract from the Commercial Register or a Certificate of Incorporation of the Assignee, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate.

MERGER

Filing Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate; and
2. A Certificate of merger, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate.

LICENSE

Filing Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate; and
2. A License agreement, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate.

PATENT

Requirements:

National Patent Application

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate;
2. An Extract from the Commercial Register or Articles of Incorporation, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to Bahrain Consulate;
3. A Deed of Assignment from the inventor(s), duly legalized by Apostille OR up to Bahrain Consulate;
4. The priority document. If the said document is in a language other than English, an English and a certified Arabic translation of the same must be provided thereof.
5. Specifications, claims, abstract and drawings in English, together with certified Arabic translations;
6. Certificate of deposit of microorganism culture if the application is related to microorganisms.
7. Documents indicating that the inventor got the genetic resource or traditional knowledge legally (if the application is related to genetic resources or traditional knowledge).

PCT Patent Application

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate;
2. A Deed of Assignment from the inventor(s), duly legalized by Apostille or up to Bahrain Consulate;
3. Specifications, claims, abstract and drawings in English, together with certified Arabic translations;
4. PCT documents, publication sheet, search and examination reports. (optional)
5. Certificate of deposit of microorganism culture if the application is related to microorganisms.
6. Documents indicating that the inventor got the genetic resource or traditional knowledge legally (if the application is related to genetic resources or traditional knowledge).

DESIGN

Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate;
2. A Deed of Assignment from the designer(s), duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate;
3. An Extract from the applicant's entry on the Commercial Register or Articles of Incorporation or Association, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate;
4. A certified copy of the priority document, if priority is claimed. If the said document is in a language other than English, an English translation of the same must be provided thereof, together with an Arabic translation; and
5. Three representation of the design.

COPYRIGHT

Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate;
2. A Deed of Assignment, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to Bahrain Consulate, if the applicant is not the author;
3. An Extract from the Commercial Register or Certificate of Incorporation of the applicant, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate; and
4. A copy of the work.

DOMAIN NAME

Requirements:

1. A written request in the letterhead of the applicant requesting the registration of the domain name;
2. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized by Apostille OR up to the Bahrain Consulate; and
3. A copy of Extract from the Commercial Register or Certificate of Incorporation of the applicant.
