## **TRADEMARK**

### **REGISTRATION**

#### **Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate;
2. Fifteen prints of the mark; and
3. In case of claiming priority, a certified copy of the corresponding home or foreign application of the trademark, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate.

- The Power of Attorney could be filed belatedly at an extra cost.
- The POA in the name of same applicant may be used for subsequent filings.

#### **Time frame:**

- 1) Filing up to Examination: 13-18 months
- 2) Examination up to Publication: 1-2 months from the time of acceptance
- 3) Opposition Period: 60 days from the publication date
- 4) End of opposition period up to issuance of registration certificate: Within 2 months
- 5) Total estimated time frame: 18-24 months

*The above time frame is for a normal/smooth processing of a trademark application, in case of no objections by the trademark examiner or no oppositions from a third party.*

### **RENEWAL**

#### **Filing Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate.

## **CHANGE OF NAME OR ADDRESS**

### **Filing Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate; and
2. A Certified copy of change of name/address certificate.

## **ASSIGNMENT**

### **Filing Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate;
2. A Deed of Assignment from both parties, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate; and
3. An Extract from the Commercial Register or Article of Incorporation, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate.

## **MERGER**

### **Filing Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate; and
2. A Certificate of merger, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate.

## **LICENSE**

### **Filing Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate;
2. A License agreement, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate; and
3. Article of incorporation, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate.

# **PATENT**

### **Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate;
2. An Extract from the Commercial Register or Certificate of Incorporation or any equivalent document, if the applicant is a company, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate;
3. A Deed of Assignment from the inventor(s), duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate, if the applicant is not the inventor OR a copy of the original assignment as filed with the basic foreign application, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate;
4. Specifications, claims, abstract and drawings; and
5. A certified copy of the corresponding home application, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate, in case of claiming priority.

## **CHANGE OF NAME OR ADDRESS**

### **Filing Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate; and
2. A Change of name/address certificate, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate.

## **ASSIGNMENT**

### **Filing Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate;
2. A Deed of Assignment from both parties, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate; and
3. An Extract from the Commercial Register or Certificate of Incorporation, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate.

## **MERGER**

### **Filing Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate; and
2. A Certificate of Merger, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate.

## **LICENSE**

### **Filing Requirements:**

1. Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate;
2. A License agreement, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate; and
3. Article of incorporation, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate.

# **DESIGN**

### **Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate;
2. An Extract from the Commercial Register or Certificate of Incorporation, if the applicant is a company, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate;
3. A Deed of Assignment, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate, if the applicant is not the designer;
4. A set of formal drawings, representations, description and illustration; and
5. A certified copy of the priority document, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate, if priority is claimed.

## **CHANGE OF NAME OR ADDRESS**

### **Filing Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate; and
2. A Change of name/address certificate, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate.

## **ASSIGNMENT**

### **Filing Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate;
2. A Deed of Assignment from both parties, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate; and
3. An Extract from the Commercial Register or Certificate of Incorporation, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate.

## **MERGER**

### **Filing Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate;
2. A Certificate of Merger, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate; and
3. Article of Incorporation, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate

# **COPYRIGHT**

### **Requirements:**

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to the Egyptian Consulate;
2. A copy of the artwork, stamped and mentioning the name of the signatory and title or a certificate of registration of the Artwork in any country;
3. Particulars/details of the Author and Publisher; and
4. A copy of the work.

# **DOMAIN NAME**

### **Requirements for Domain name ending with .com.eg:**

1. A Certificate of incorporation in Egypt;
2. Tax card; and
3. Egyptian Trademark Registration Certificate of the same trademark required for the domain name (registered at least 5 years ago).
