TRADEMARK

REGISTRATION

Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention;
2. An Extract from Commercial Register or Articles of Incorporation or its equivalent, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention; and
3. Ten prints of the mark.
 - The Power of Attorney can be filed belatedly at an extra cost.
 - The POA in the name of same applicant may be used for subsequent filings.

Time frame:

- 1) Filing up to Examination: 4-6 months
- 2) Examination up to Publication: 4-6 months
- 3) Opposition Period: 3 months from the publication date
- 4) End of opposition period up to issuance of registration certificate: 2 months
- 5) Total estimated time frame: 12-16 months

The above time frame is for a normal/smooth processing of a trademark application, in case of no objections by the trademark examiner or no oppositions from a third party.

RENEWAL

Filing Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention.

CHANGE OF NAME OR ADDRESS

Filing Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention; and
2. A Certificate of change of name and/or address, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention.

ASSIGNMENT

Filing Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney from the Assignee, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention;
2. A Deed of Assignment, signed by both parties duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention; and
3. An Extract from Commercial Register or Articles of Incorporation or its equivalent, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention.

MERGER

Filing Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney from the entity surviving the merger, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention;
2. A Certificate of merger, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention; and
3. An Extract from Commercial Register or Articles of Incorporation or its equivalent, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention.

LICENSE

Filing Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney from the Licensee, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention;
2. A License agreement, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention; and

3. An Extract from Commercial Register or Articles of Incorporation or its equivalent, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention.

PATENT

Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention;
2. If the applicant is different from the inventor, an Assignment from the inventor(s), duly legalized up to the Omani Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention;
3. Specifications, claims, abstract and formal drawings.
4. An Extract from the Commercial Register or Articles of Incorporation, or any equivalent document.
5. Copies of the International search report and preliminary examination, copy of the PCT application as published.

DESIGN

Information:

The Design Law No. 39/2000 came into effect on June 3, 2000. However, the Implementing Regulations are yet to be issued. The only available means of protecting design is publishing cautionary notices in Arabic and English in local newspapers.

Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney from the designer, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention;
2. A Deed of assignment, signed by designer, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention; and
3. The title and drawings of the design, supported by brief description.
4. A certified copy of the priority document.

COPYRIGHT

Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney from the designer, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention;
2. An Extract from Commercial Register or Articles of Incorporation or its equivalent, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention;
3. Three copies of the work; and
4. A certified copy of home or any foreign registration of the copyright.

DOMAIN NAME

Requirements:

1. A Power of Attorney from the designer, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention;
2. An Extract from Commercial Register or Articles of Incorporation or its equivalent, duly legalized up to Oman Consulate or to be authenticated or certified by Apostille, if the applicant's home country is a member of the Apostille Convention;
3. Particulars of the owner of domain name;
4. A certified copy of the license agreement, if the domain name denotes a licensed trademark;
and
5. Primary Server IP Address.
